

































Unemployed New Jersey Residents November 2018 - November 2019






New Jersey Counties Unemployment Rates - October 2019

(Preliminary, Not Seasonally Adjusted)




New Jersey Counties Unemployed Residents - October 2019

(Preliminary, Not Seasonally Adjusted)




New Jersey Counties Labor Force Per Square Mile - October 2019
