- Learn about opportunities in vocational or trade schools.


Some clients will qualify for:

- Individuals referred from the Board of Social Services through the Workforce NJ program.

What You Can Expect

Individual counseling and vocational guidance, job search workshops, and federal bonding are among our services. Use our computers, phones, faxes and copiers to conduct your job search.

If you served in the U.S. Armed Forces, you'll find specialists versed in employment programs geared specifically to veterans.

Or, if you wish to start your own business, you'll find guidance through the Entrepreneurial Training Program for the Unemployed.

What You Can Expect

- Vocational counseling and career planning.
- Vocational evaluation and guidance.
- Employment training.
- Education skills training.
- Job coaching.
- Supported employment.
- Job placement services.
- Follow-up services.

Business Incentives

Employers who hire people with disabilities will get free consultation services, including training reimbursement tax incentives, job matching with qualified workers, information about the Americans With Disabilities Act, job modification and worksite evaluations, support for disabled employees with job challenges, and follow-up to ensure employer/employee satisfaction.

Who We Can Help

Individuals seeking training, education, and/or certification programs.

What You Can Expect

In addition to counseling, you can get:

- Individual vocational guidance.
- Aptitude and interest-based testing.
- Literacy services (ABE, ESL, GED prep and basic computer literacy).
- Resource materials.
- Employment workshops to enhance your job search.
- A training grant or tuition waiver for an "in-demand" occupation (as determined by the NJ Department of Labor).
- On-the-job training grants.
- Access to computer, phone, fax and copier for job searching.

How to Start

Job seekers interested in training opportunities must complete an intake at Employment Services to be referred to the Career Training Services Center. (Note: Not all who apply will be eligible.)
