

On September 23<sup>rd</sup>, Steven Simon, Ph.D., President/CEO Human Services Outcomes Inc. and renowned author of the book *RELAUNCH! Stagnation*, *Change*, *and Renewal in Mid-Career and Beyond* was the featured speaker at a webinar event coordinated by Jan Goodman from the One Stop Career Center in collaboration with the New Start Career Network and the John J. Heldrich Center for Workforce Development at Rutgers University. This event drew the attention of job seekers, counselors and career coaches from around the state with nearly 100 participants tuning in live via Zoom to receive a message of hope and action for finding career fulfillment at all points in the career journey. Dr. Simon shared his own experience of having to shift employment mid-career and then presented the model he developed that supports folks in finding employment that ignites passion and brings meaning to their work. This workshop coincided well with this crossroads where we stand as job seekers begin to re-enter the workforce into a new world that continues to be shaped by the global health crisis. The One Stop will continue to collaborate with speakers that can bring us fresh perspectives on job seeking as we continue to navigate through these rapidly changing times. 
