The Greater Raritan Workforce Development Board is looking for interested youth, ages 16 to 24, who are interested in applying for one of up to 30 part-time summer internship positions in Hunterdon and Somerset counties.

The Greater Raritan Workforce Development Board SUMMER YOUTH EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM DETAILS:

- DURATION:** Eight-week period between June 7th and October 31st.
- AGE:** Candidates must be between the ages of 16 and 24 and can be in school or out of school.
- REQUIREMENTS:** Interns accepted into the program will work 25 hours per week, including four hours per week of different work-readiness training led by staff and system partners, and mandatory completion of online courses offered through SkillUp Greater Raritan.

EMPLOYERS:

Any employer in Hunterdon and Somerset counties with available remote or in-person part-time positions can apply to be part of the project. The internship opportunities can be in any sector in the two counties, from office or web support to recreational or nonprofit work.

Employers will receive the full stipend to pay each intern.
