

# **How Can YES Help?**

The Youth Employment Service Program offers the following FREE services to out of school youth and young adults 16 to 24:

- Case Management
- Tutoring and Instruction
- Investment Training Grant up to \$4,000 for eligible training programs
- 14 hours of PAID Job Skills Training (\$10/hr.)
- ☑ Job Application Assistance
- ☑ Resume Writing
- ☑ Job Interviewing Skills
- ☑ Assistance In Locating Job Opportunities
- Participate in up to 20 hrs. (4 weeks) of paid career sampling (\$10/hr.)
- Earn one of many valuable workplace credentials





# Who is Eligible?

All Out of School Youth 16-24 Years Old High School Graduate or Drop-Out

If you are a resident of Hunterdon or Somerset County, are between the ages of 16 and 24, out of school and possess one or more of the following challenges, you will be eligible to participate in the YES Program.

- Have a physical, mental health, or learning disability diagnosis
- · Pregnant or parenting
- · Runaway or homeless
- · Juvenile justice or criminal justice involved
- Individual with recent substance abuse or dependency
- Involved in the Foster Care System
