

Greater Raritan Pathways to Recovery

How do you answer the following questions:

Do you, a friend or any family member have a history of opioid use?

Did you become unemployed or underemployed as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic?

If you answered “yes” to both questions and live in Hunterdon or Somerset Counties, you may be eligible to participate in the Greater Raritan Pathways to Recovery program.

This new state-funded program aims to assist those impacted directly or indirectly by the opioid epidemic and who are unemployed or underemployed. This is a program of the Greater Raritan Workforce Development Board working in collaboration with Prevention Links and the Greater Raritan One-Stop Career Training Center.

Participants in this career-focused program receive:

- Training opportunities focusing on in-demand occupations or training for certification as a Peer Recovery Specialist
- Career readiness and soft skills training to support job success, including enrollment in the SkillUp Job Readiness Badge program
- Employment case management and mentoring
- Access to supportive services to overcome barriers and achieve goals
