

If the opioid epidemic has impacted you directly or indirectly, as a family member or friend, and you have an employment need, you may be eligible to participate in the Greater Raritan Workforce Development Board Pathways to Recovery program.

## This career-focused program includes:

- In-demand occupation training opportunities through the Greater Raritan One-Stop Career Training Center or Peer Recovery Specialist certification training coupled with 500 hours of paid experience
- Career readiness and soft skills training with program partner Prevention Links to support job success, including enrollment in the SkillUp Greater Raritan Job Readiness Badge program
- Individual employment case management and mentoring from Prevention Links
- Access to supportive services from Prevention Links to overcome barriers and achieve goals
