Mission: Through collaboration with state and local partners, the Greater Raritan Workforce Development Board Operations Committee will ensure that residents of Hunterdon and Somerset counties are receiving services that focus on career pathways and in-demand occupations that result in sustainable wages. - Monitor the monthly local dashboard maintained by the One-Stop to see if there are any data sets not being collected that could better inform decision-making.
