What is an Apprenticeship?

An Apprenticeship is a paid position where participants become skilled in a trade or profession-they 'earn while they learn.' Apprenticeship training combines classroom learning with hands-on work.

The benefits of an Apprenticeship.

The average starting wage at the completion of an apprenticeship program is \$50,000. Employers can create career ladder pathways for the organizations. Apprenticeships can be used to bring new staff on or upskill current staff.
