Get career-building experience, and get paid up to \$3,000, too!

The Greater Raritan Workforce Development Board is looking for youth, ages 16 to 24, who are interested in applying for one of up to 80 part-time summer work experience/internship positions in Hunterdon and Somerset counties.

The Greater Raritan Workforce Development Board SUMMER YOUTH EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM DETAILS:

- DURATION:** Any eight-week period between June 5, 2023, and Oct. 30, 2023.
- AGE:** Candidates must be between the ages of 16 and 24 and can be in school or out of school.
- BENEFITS:** Youth accepted into the program will work 25 hours per week for **eight weeks**. The experience is comprised of 21 hours per week with the employer and an additional four hours per week working on a virtual SkillUp Job Readiness program. Each participant will be paid **\$15 an hour**, for a total of **\$3,000** if all of the 200 hours of the experience are completed.

EMPLOYERS:

Among the employer participants from Hunterdon and Somerset Counties in 2023 are county and municipal governmental offices, including finance, economic development and engineering departments, nonprofit administration, facilities maintenance, local animal shelters, a private salon, retail businesses and more.
