About the job

The Literacy Navigator will connect adults in immigrant communities with English instruction, job skills and placement services, and other supportive community resources. The primary focus of the job will be increasing access to beginner-level English instruction in communities hardest hit by the pandemic. Better English skills will help students improve job prospects, support their children at school, gain independence, and actively engage in the local community.

We are looking for a Literacy Navigator to:

- Coordinate registration and enrollment events in immigrant communities.
- Assess adult students for eligibility.
- Enroll students in appropriate ESL services.
- Work closely with teachers and students to ensure attendance and progress in acquiring everyday English skills.
- Connect students with supportive community resources.
- Collect and maintain student demographic and enrollment data, monitor student attendance and progress, and report student outcomes.

Requirements

- Bachelor's degree and several years of work experience (in a field such as teaching, social work, or project management)
- Passion and interest in helping immigrants
- English and Spanish fluency
- Proficiency in basic computer skills
- Independent, organized individual with excellent communication and project management skills.
- Experience or interest in one or more of the following: literacy, teaching, community service, workforce development, cultural diversity.

LVSC serves 400 local adults who struggle to read, write, and communicate in English. Our free programs include English tutoring, English conversation groups, and U.S. citizenship preparation. Instruction is provided by a network of 175 trained volunteer tutors.
