REQUIREMENTS

AGE

Candidates must be at least 21 years of age by December 31, 2023, and NOT have reached their 35th birthday at the time of appointment to the Police Academy Training Program ("PTC"); unless covered by the PTC age requirement guideline New Jersey Statute; N.J.S.A. 43:16A-3

CITIZENSHIP

Candidates must be citizens of the United States on the date of application submission, and never have renounced United States citizenship.

DRIVER'S LICENSE

Candidates must have a driving record in good standing and valid motor vehicle driver's license on the date of application submission.

- Sixty (60) college credits, plus one

 (1) year of full-time or part-time experience as a first responder
 (e.g., Paramedic/ EMT/ ClassI/ ClassII/ Police Dispatcher/ Corrections/ Firefighter/ or related); OR
- Thirty (30) college credits plus at least two (2) full years of continuous active-duty military service with an honorable discharge. OR
- 4 full years of continuous activeduty military services.
