


# Greater Raritan One-Stop May Highlights

The Greater Raritan One-Stop Leadership Team is exploring strategizes to improve customer outcomes. On May 22nd they facilitated a strategy meeting to increase Work First New Jersey (WFNJ) participation and placement rates. They decided to implement employment pipelines for compliant WFNJ customers. They're currently in the process of identifying customers to enroll and outreaching prospective employers.

On May 6th, they facilitated an Apprentice Recruitment Event at Raritan Valley Community Colleges. On May 16th, the Greater Raritan One-Stop Operator and the Greater Raritan Workforce Development Board Director met with Union County American Job Center leadership team. They shared best practices and strategies to better serve our communities. The Greater Raritan One-Stop is committed to continuous process and workflow improvement.



# Message from Greater Raritan Workforce Development Board Director

I am pleased to report that our June 4 Greater Raritan Job Fair at the Hindu Temple in Bridgewater drew about 450 job seekers who met with around 75 employers (we had several no-shows, which is slightly irksome, but it happens). I talked to many people throughout the event and afterward and the feedback was largely positive. I am following up with the employers to ask them to let us know who they hire, and with the job seekers to remind them about our many resources. A story also will be placed on our homepage.

We have begun working in earnest to promote the June 22 Cannabis Town Hall and Career Fair on June 22 at RVCC; we've had additional businesses join in the past week, along with NJDOL representatives and panelists. This promises to be an interesting event. (By the way, the Expungement Clinic is open to any interested individual in the community.) 
