Takeaways

- As of 2024 the region's population increased by 6.3% since 2019, growing by 28,680. Population is expected to increase by 5.4% between 2024 and 2029, adding 26,301.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs declined by 0.1% in 2 New Jersey Counties from 260,842 to 260,688. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.9% by 4.0%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 66.1% to 63.6% between 2019 and 2024.
- Concerning educational attainment, **31.8% of the selected regions' residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (10.4% above the national average), and **6.3% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.6% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Management of Companies and Enterprises, and Computer Systems Design and Related Services.




Dec 2024 Labor Force Breakdown



Educational Attainment






Unemployment by Gender



Unemployment by Ethnicity







Job Trends










Millennials


Retiring Soon












Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP






Top Growing Occupations





Top Occupation Employment Concentration












In 2023, there were 1,134 graduates in 2 New Jersey Counties. This pipeline has shrunk by 13% over the last 5 years.
