

GREATER RARITAN WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT BOARD (GRWDB)

Has oversight responsibilities of the One-Stop system in Hunterdon and Somerset Counties. Offers some direct services, including SkillUp and Resume Portal platforms, along with Summer Youth and OPG programs, and for businesses, Incumbent Worker Training and On-the-Job Training. The GRWDB also contracts the One-Stop Operator to provide oversight and guidance regarding customer flow and outcomes.

CUSTOMER ENTRY INTO ONE-STOP SYSTEM

NJDOL EMPLOYMENT SERVICES

The main system entry for all customers provides a comprehensive needs assessment, determines co-enrollment connections, and initiates them.

HUNTERDON POLYTECH (Y.E.S.)

Hunterdon County youth recruitment extension of Y.E.S.

MIDDLE EARTH (Y.E.S.)

Somerset County recruitment extension of Y.E.S. Recruits out of school youth 16 - 24 with one or more of the eligibility barriers.

HUNTERDON COUNTY DIVISION OF SOCIAL SERVICES

Refers WFNJ clients.

SOMERSET COUNTY BOARD OF SOCIAL SERVICES

Refers WFNJ clients.

DIVISION OF VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION SERVICES

Enables eligible individuals with disabilities to achieve an employment outcome consistent with their strengths, priorities, needs, abilities, and capabilities.

NEW JERSEY COMMISSION for the BLIND and VISUALLY IMPAIRED

If individual is blind or visually impaired and can benefit from specialized education, employment, independent living, and eye health services.

UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE BENEFITS OFFICE (UI)

Helps people laid off, fired, or quit, those unemployed due to disasters, and those seeking to reopen or extend their unemployment insurance claim after a temporary disability claim expires.

Note:

- All customer point of entry organizations are encouraged when appropriate to co-enroll with each other. Additionally, primary and secondary co-enrollment partners may serve as the initial point of entry for certain clients. This diagram illustrates the standard practice in most cases.

MAIN CO-ENROLLMENT OPTIONS

CAREER TRAINING SERVICES

If it's determined that a new career path or up-skill training is needed. Services include Individual Training Accounts for in-demand training, career assessments and counseling, supportive service dollars and, for businesses, Incumbent Worker Training and On-the-Job Training funded by the GRWDB.

YOUTH EMPLOYMENT SERVICES (Y.E.S.)

Supports out of school youth 16 - 24 with one or more of the eligibility barriers. Runs out of Career Training Services' office.

MIDDLE EARTH (Y.E.S.) / Visions Work-Based Learning

Somerset County recruitment extension of Y.E.S., also job readiness training through Visions Program. Youth must be enrolled in the YES program to participate.

WORK FIRST NEW JERSEY

Supports individuals on Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF), Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) and General Assistance (GA).

LITERACY SERVICES

Provides Adult Basic Education, GED and ESL.

PATHSTONE

Supports lower-income and over 55 years of age facing barriers to employment, provides subsidized, part-time, work-based community service training.

ADDITIONAL CO-ENROLLMENT OPTIONS

ON-THE-JOB TRAINING

An employer subsidized work-based learning opportunity that provides training to a qualified jobseeker resulting in long-term sustainable employment.

INCUMBENT WORKER TRAINING

Work-based training and upskilling for employees to acquire the skills necessary to retain employment.

NJ RE-ENTRY CORP.

If individual is justice involved, can benefit from specialized case management and job placement support.

AFRICAN AMERICAN CHAMBER OF COMMERCE/ PATHWAYS TO RECOVERY

If individual is impacted by the opioid crisis, they empower them through tools, training, and support to rebuild their lives and careers.

AFRICAN AMERICAN CHAMBER OF COMMERCE/ JOBS

Addresses barriers for justice-impacted individuals through workforce training, employment, and reintegration support.

OPPORTUNITY PARTNERSHIP TRAINING GRANT (O.P.G.)

Provide grant funding for training.

GROWING APPRENTICESHIPS IN NONTRADITIONAL SECTORS (G.A.I.N.S.)

Helps workers and others with access to on-the-job training and advanced credentials.

PRE-APPRENTICESHIP IN CAREER EDUCATION GRANT (P.A.C.E.)

Prepares individuals for Registered Apprenticeships, post-secondary education, or other career training.

NJ APPRENTICESHIP NETWORK

Offers information to job seekers on earn-while-you-learn opportunities and information to employers on launching an apprenticeship program.

DIGITAL EQUITY TRAINING

Nonprofit, for-profit, governmental and educational institutions integrate digital training into workforce programs for Work First NJ participants through computer training, industry-focused certifications and employment opportunities

SUBSTANCE ABUSE INITIATIVE (SAI)/ BEHAVIORAL HEALTH INITIATIVE (BHI)

Provides substance abuse and behavioral health screenings for WFNJ clients referred by their case workers. When needed, a treatment plan is developed, which can include counseling and related services. Participation in SAI/BHI counts as an eligible work activity for WFNJ compliance. Services are offered at the Social Services Building, first floor. Referrals must go through the client's WFNJ Social Services CaseWorker.
