
Regional average earnings per job are **\$28.0K above** the national average earnings of \$86.7K per job.

Takeaways

- As of 2024 the region's population **increased by 7.5%** since 2019, growing by 33,976. Population is expected to **increase by 6.5%** between 2024 and 2029, adding 31,678.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs **declined by 0.0%** in 2 New Jersey Counties from 260,825 to **260,760**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 4.4% by 4.4%**. As the number of jobs declined, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 67.5% to 65.5% between 2019 and 2024**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **31.9% of the selected regions' residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (10.4% above the national average), and **6.1% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.7% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Computer Systems Design and Related Services, and Management of Companies and Enterprises.



Educational Attainment







Unemployment by Gender














Racial Diversity














Top Growing Industries







Top Growing Occupations




Top Occupation Employment Concentration






