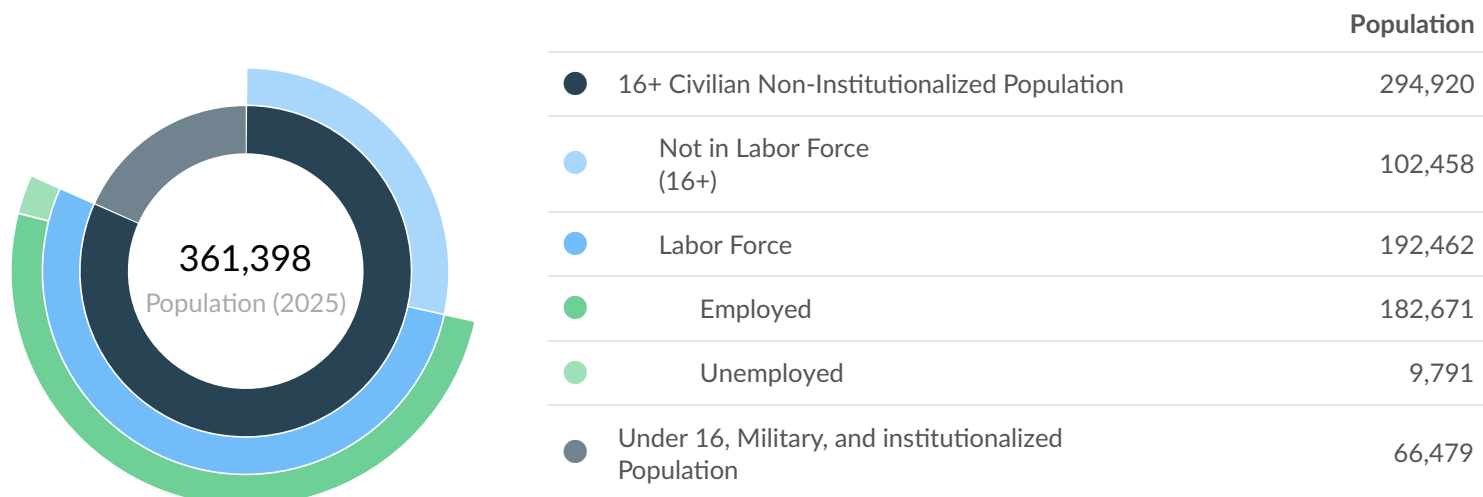
Median household income is **\$57.4K above** the national median household income of \$78.5K.

- From 2019 to 2024, jobs **increased by 0.7%** in Somerset County, NJ from 206,520 to **207,950**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 4.4% by 3.7%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 68.6% to 65.9% between 2019 and 2024**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **31.3% of Somerset County, NJ residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (9.7% above the national average), and **6.0% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.8% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Computer Systems Design and Related Services, Management of Companies and Enterprises, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).

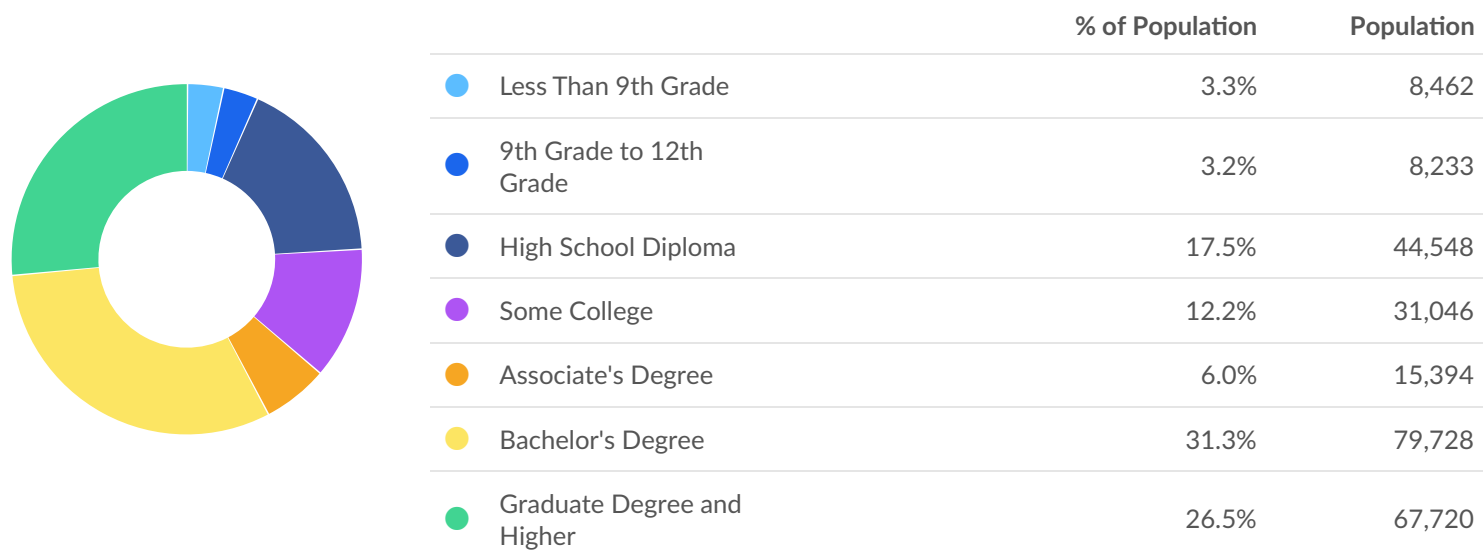

Sep 2025 Labor Force Breakdown



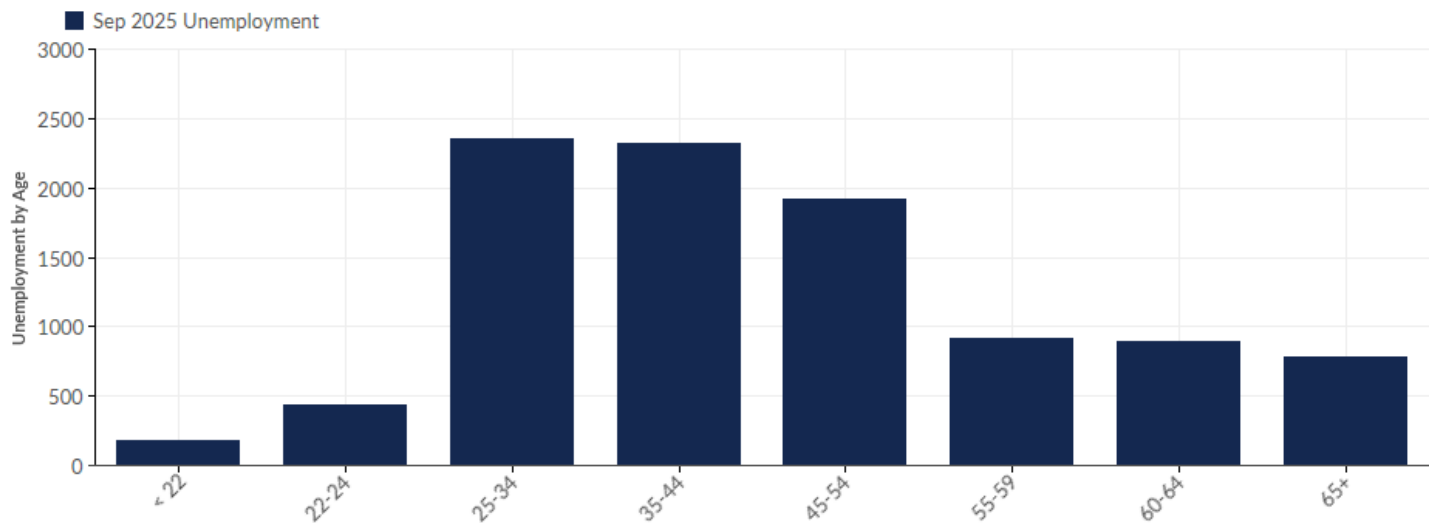
Educational Attainment

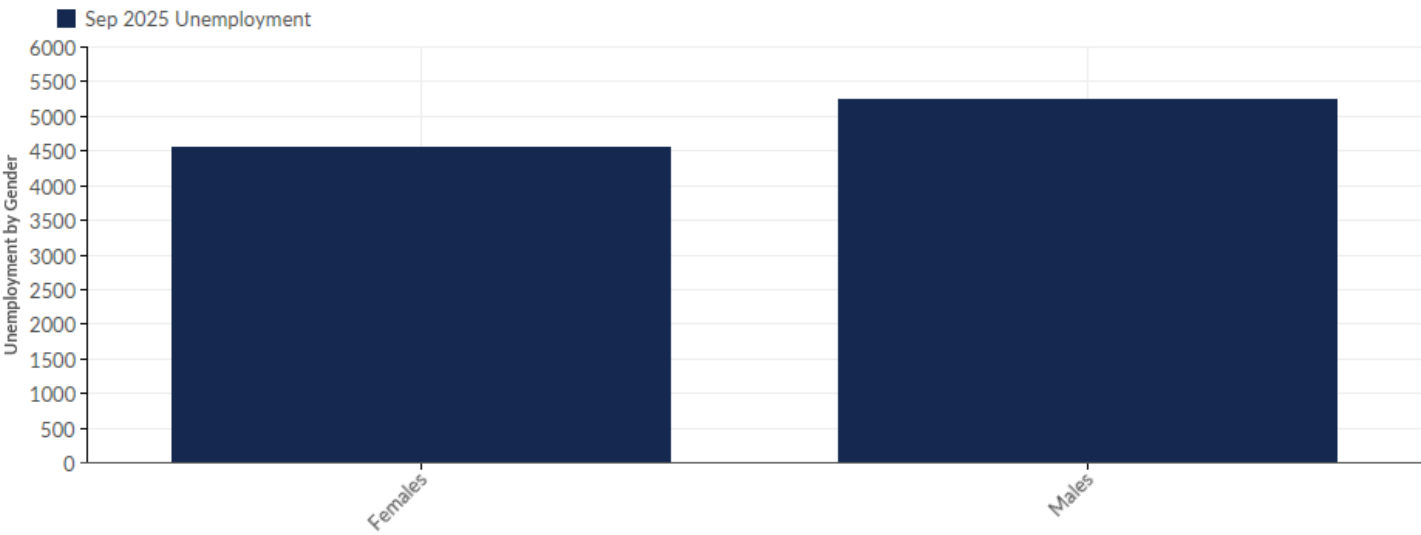

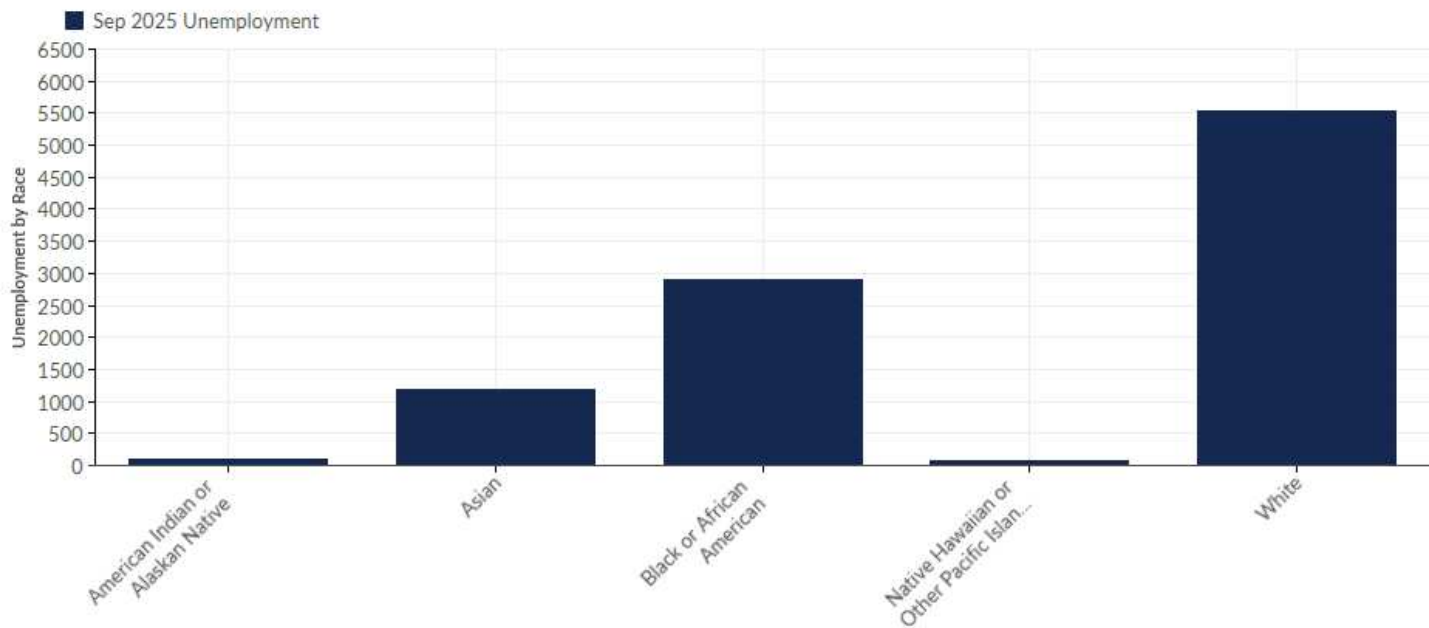

Unemployment by Gender



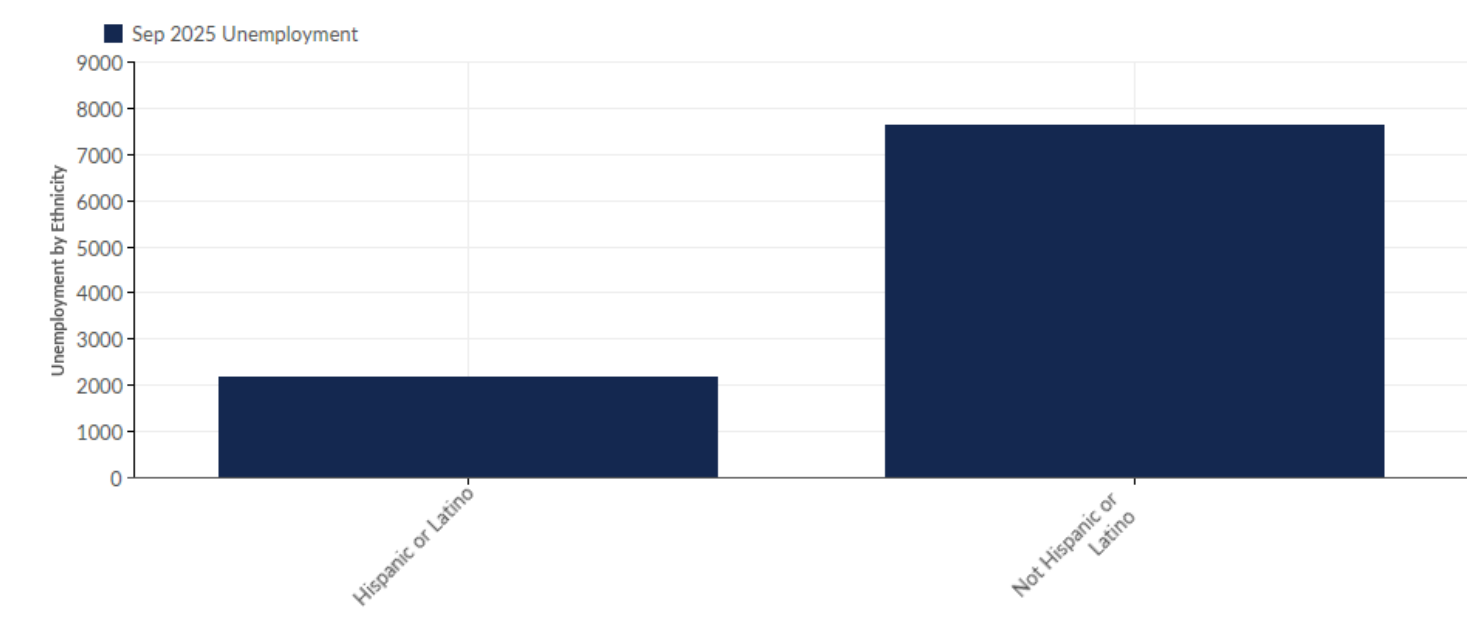

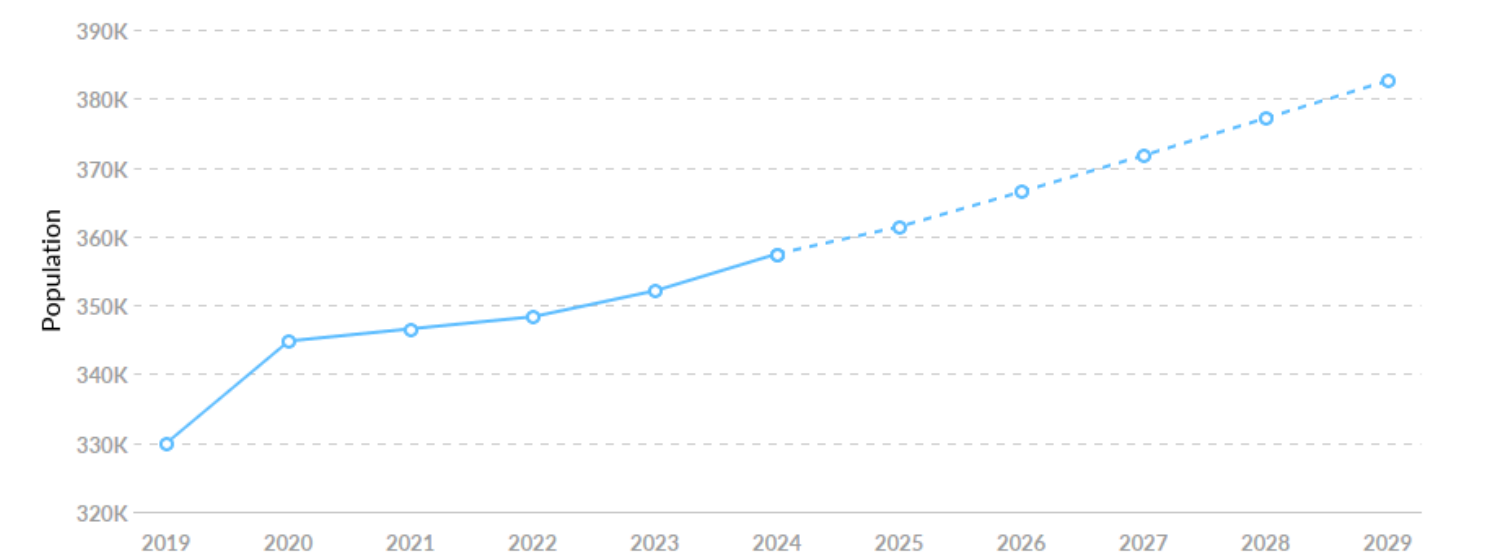

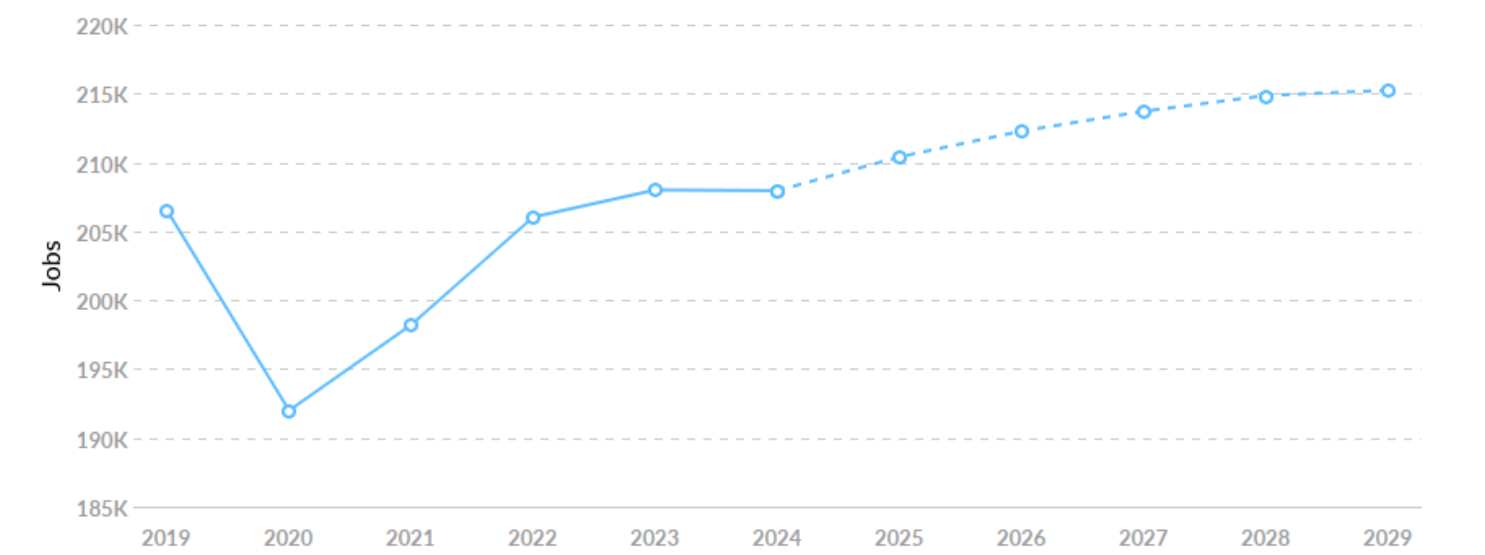

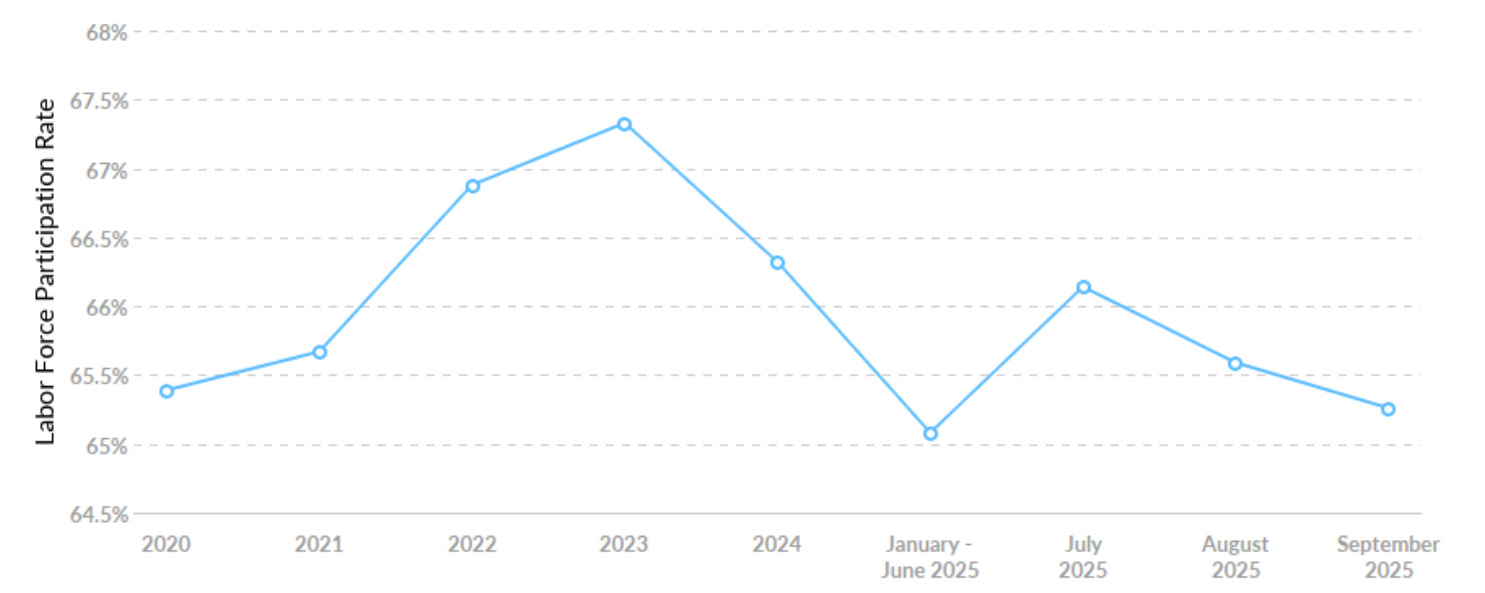
Job Trends

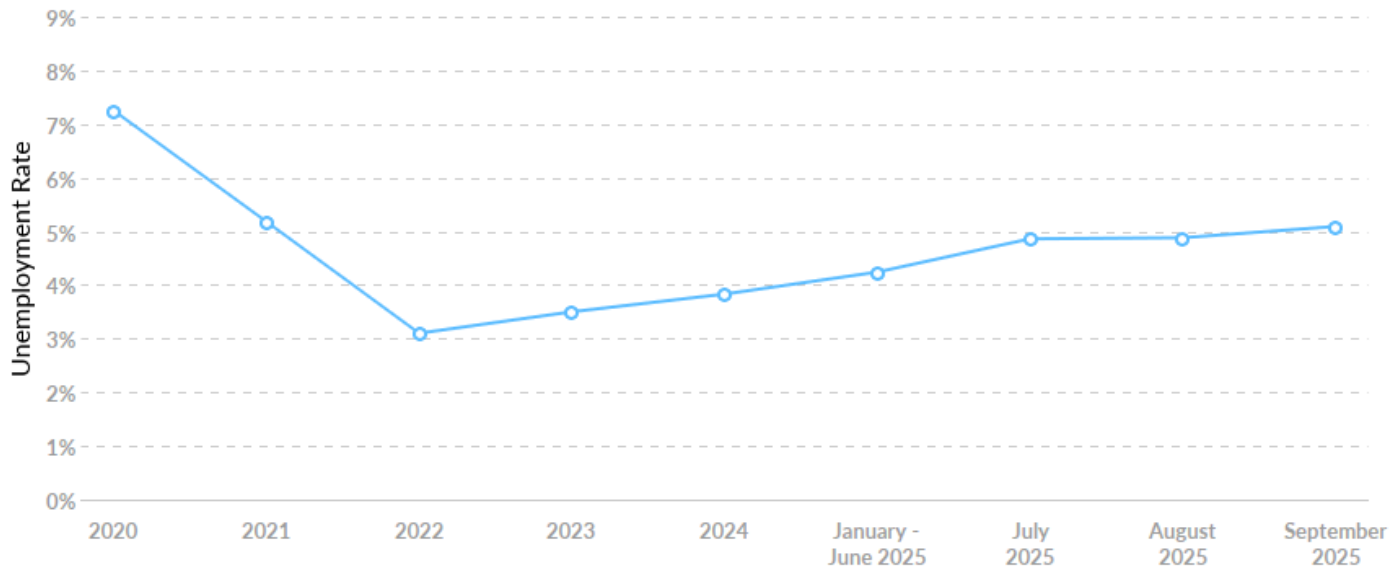

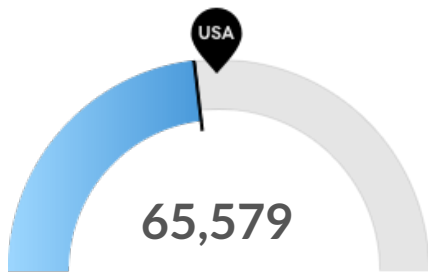
Unemployment Rate Trends

Somerset County, NJ had a September 2025 unemployment rate of 5.09%, **decreasing from 7.25%** 5 years before.



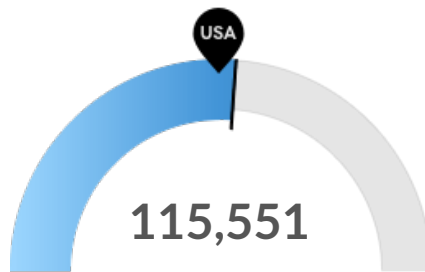

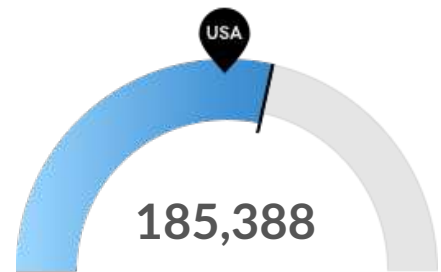
Millennials

Somerset County, NJ has 65,579 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 73,177.



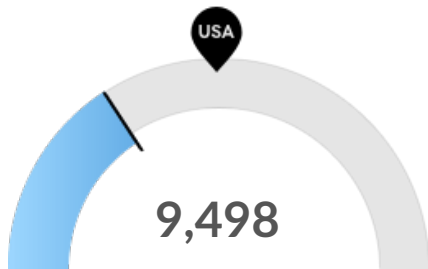
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is about average in Somerset County, NJ. The national average for an area this size is 108,090 people 55 or older, while there are 115,551 here.



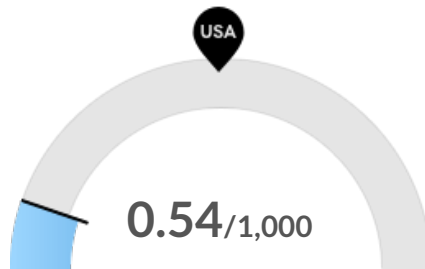
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is high in Somerset County, NJ. The national average for an area this size is 152,061 racially diverse people, while there are 185,388 here.



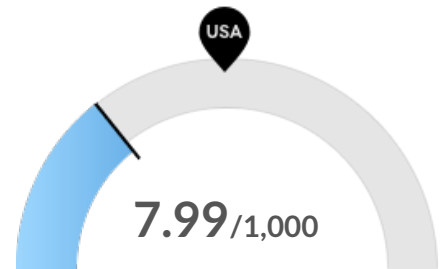
Veterans

Somerset County, NJ has 0.54 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.38 per 1,000 people.

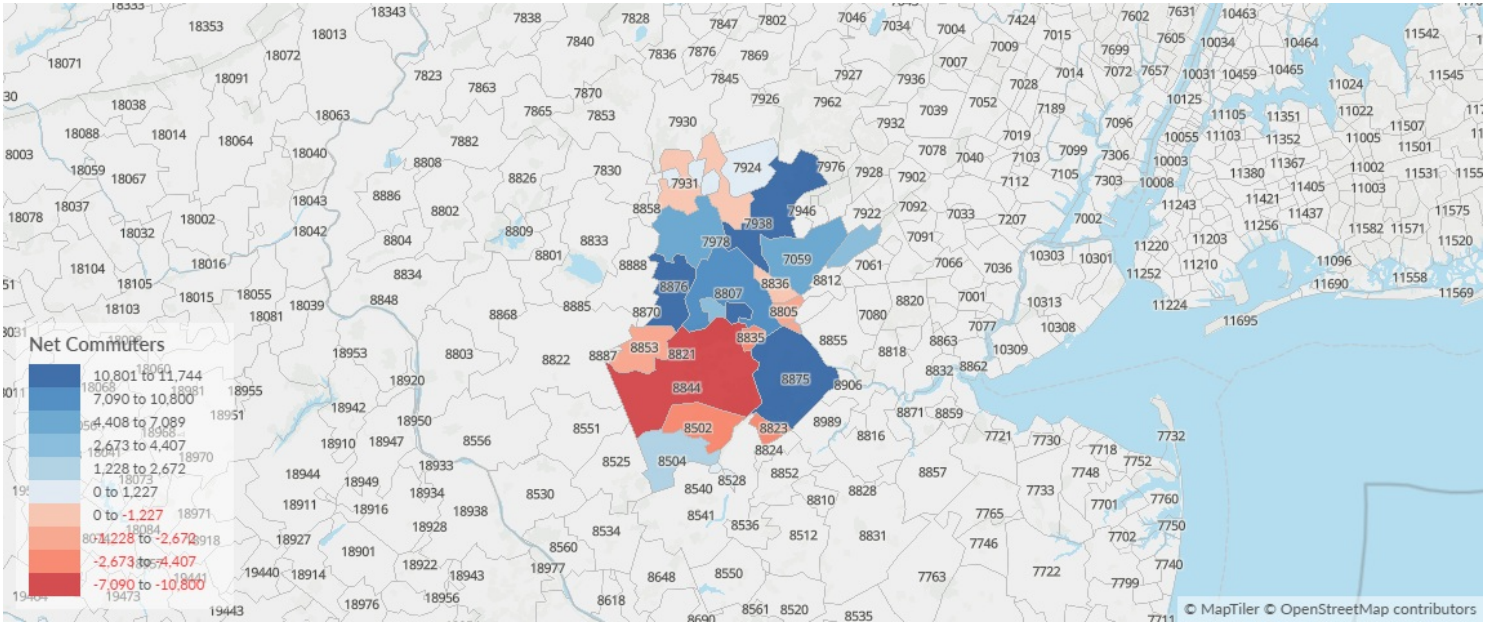


Property Crime

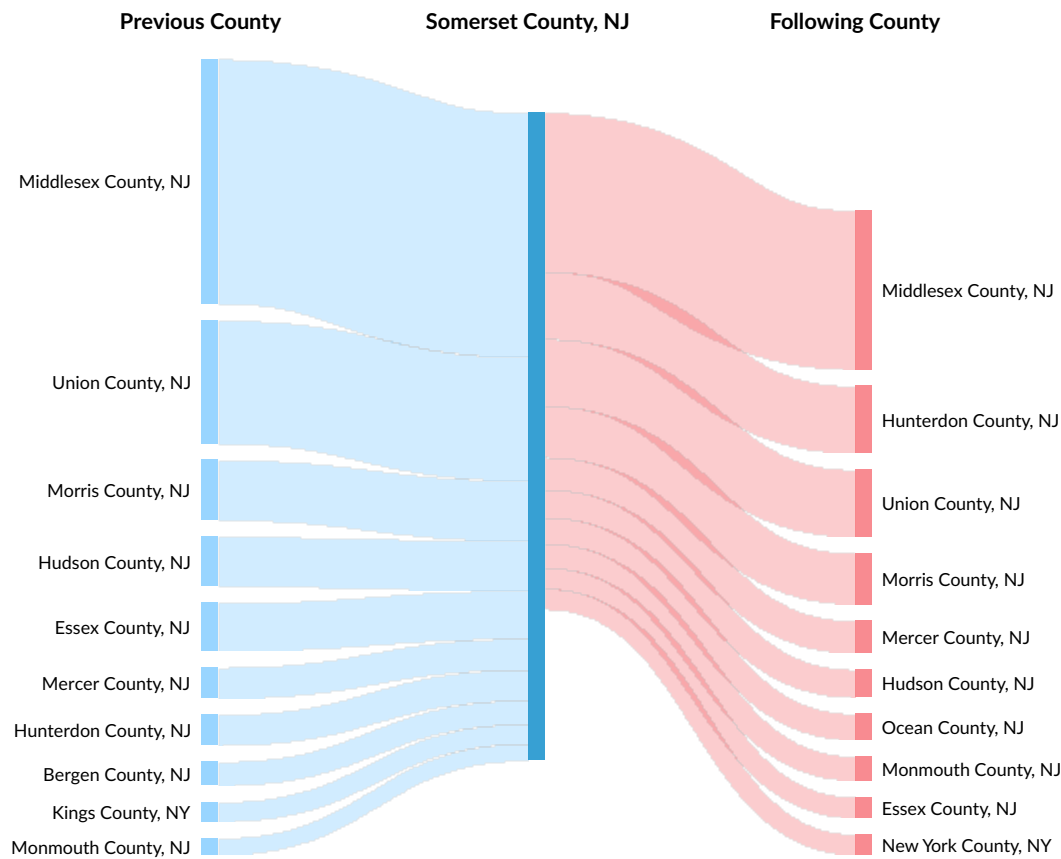

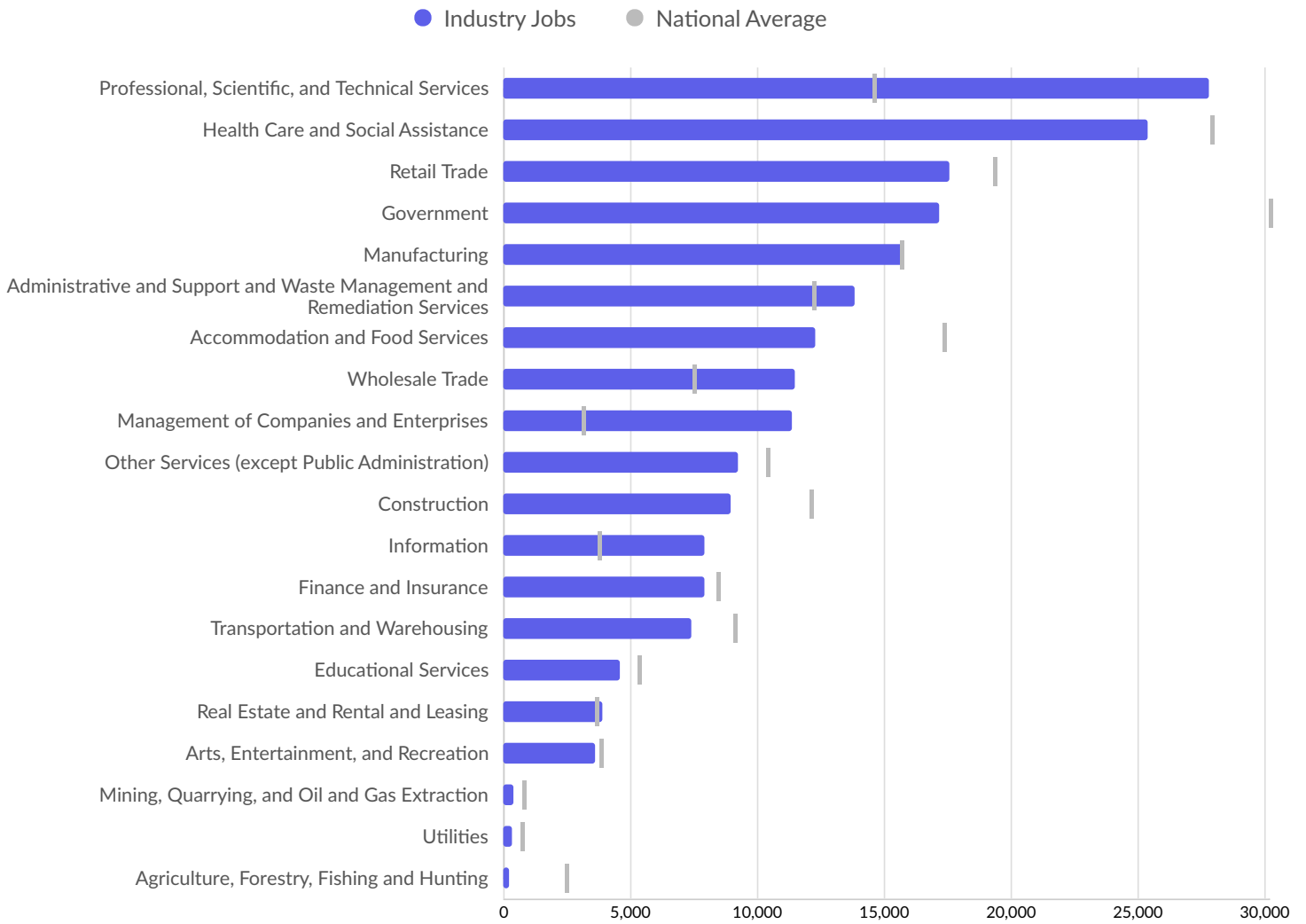

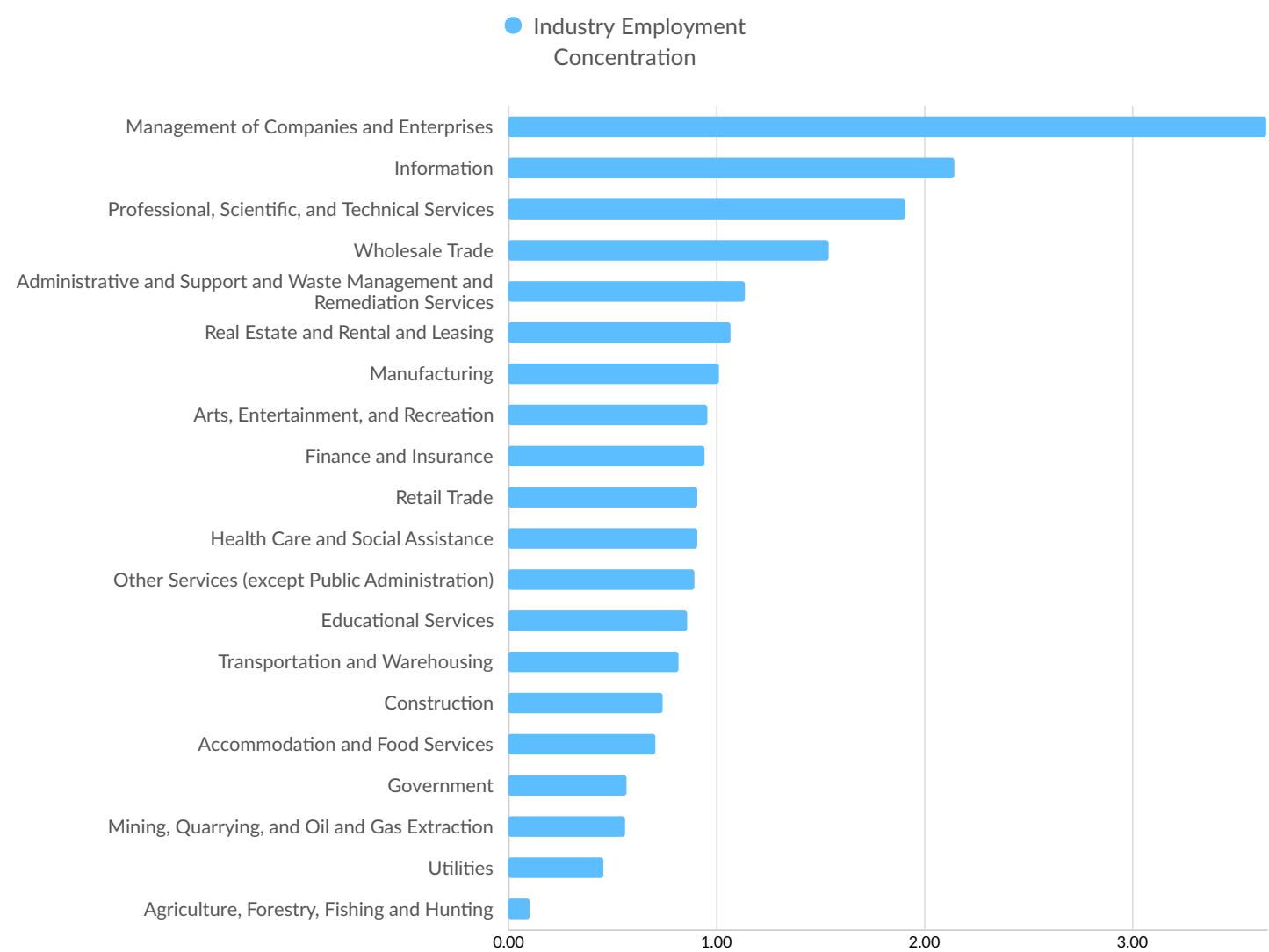

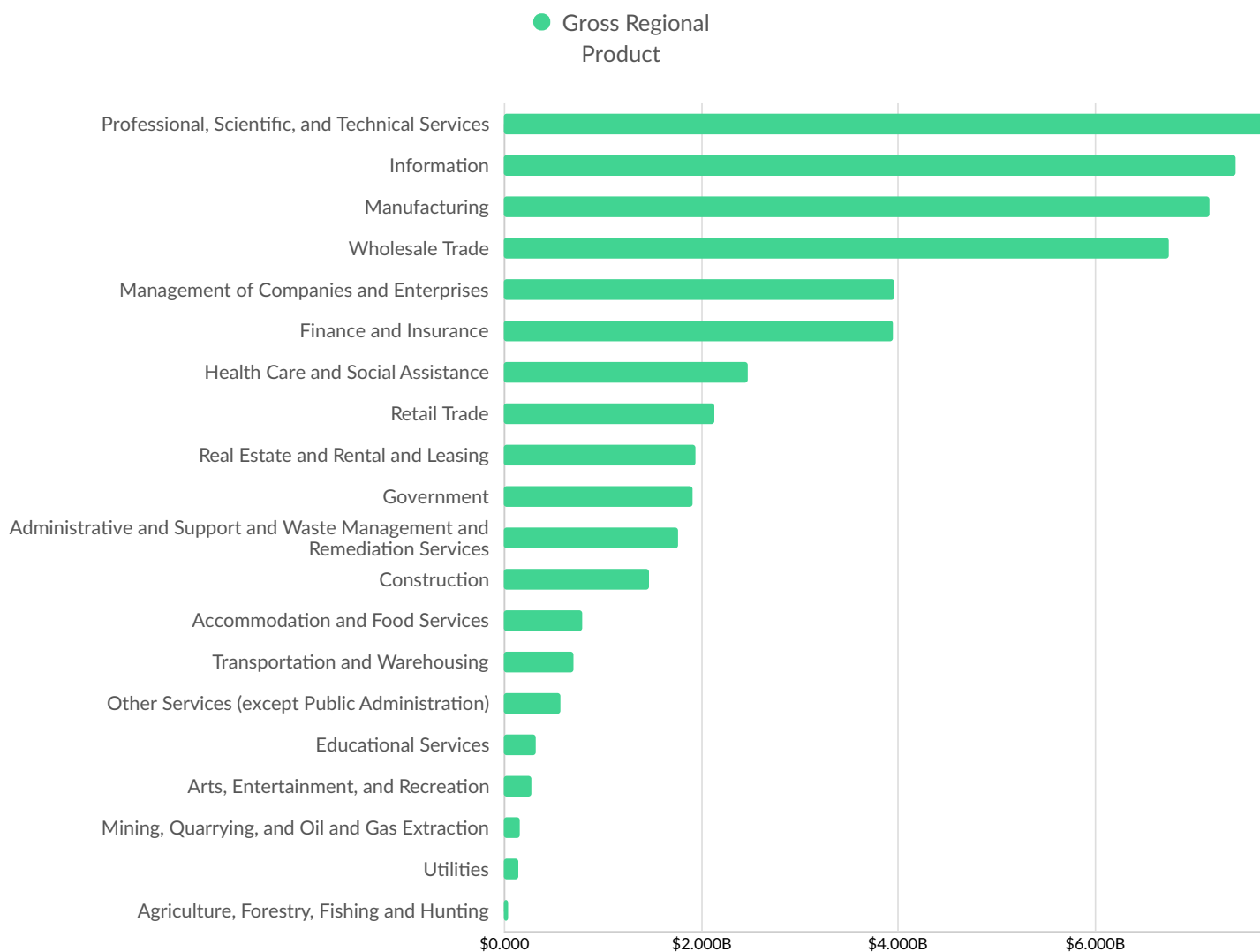
Top Growing Industries



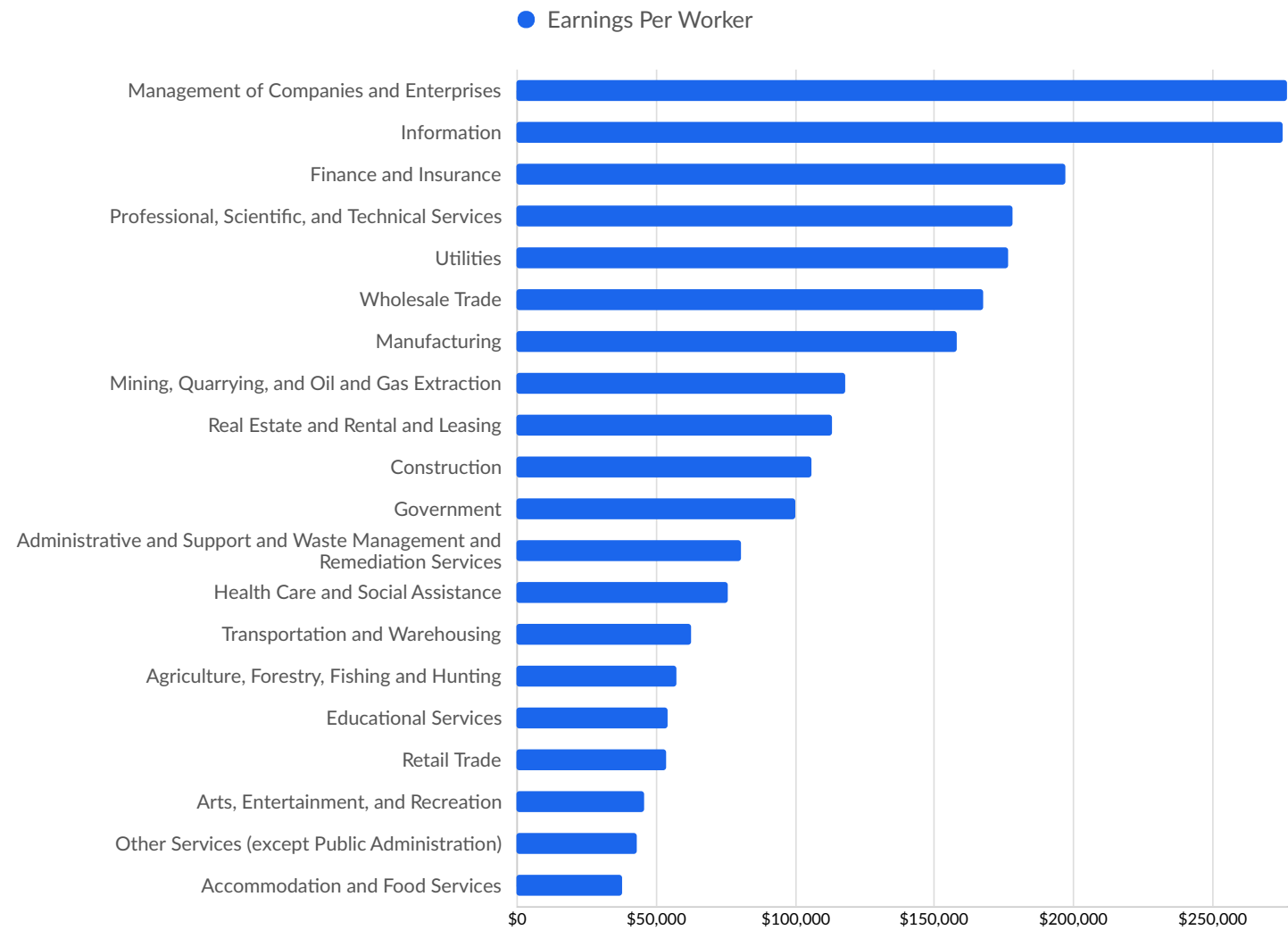
Top Industry Employment Concentration

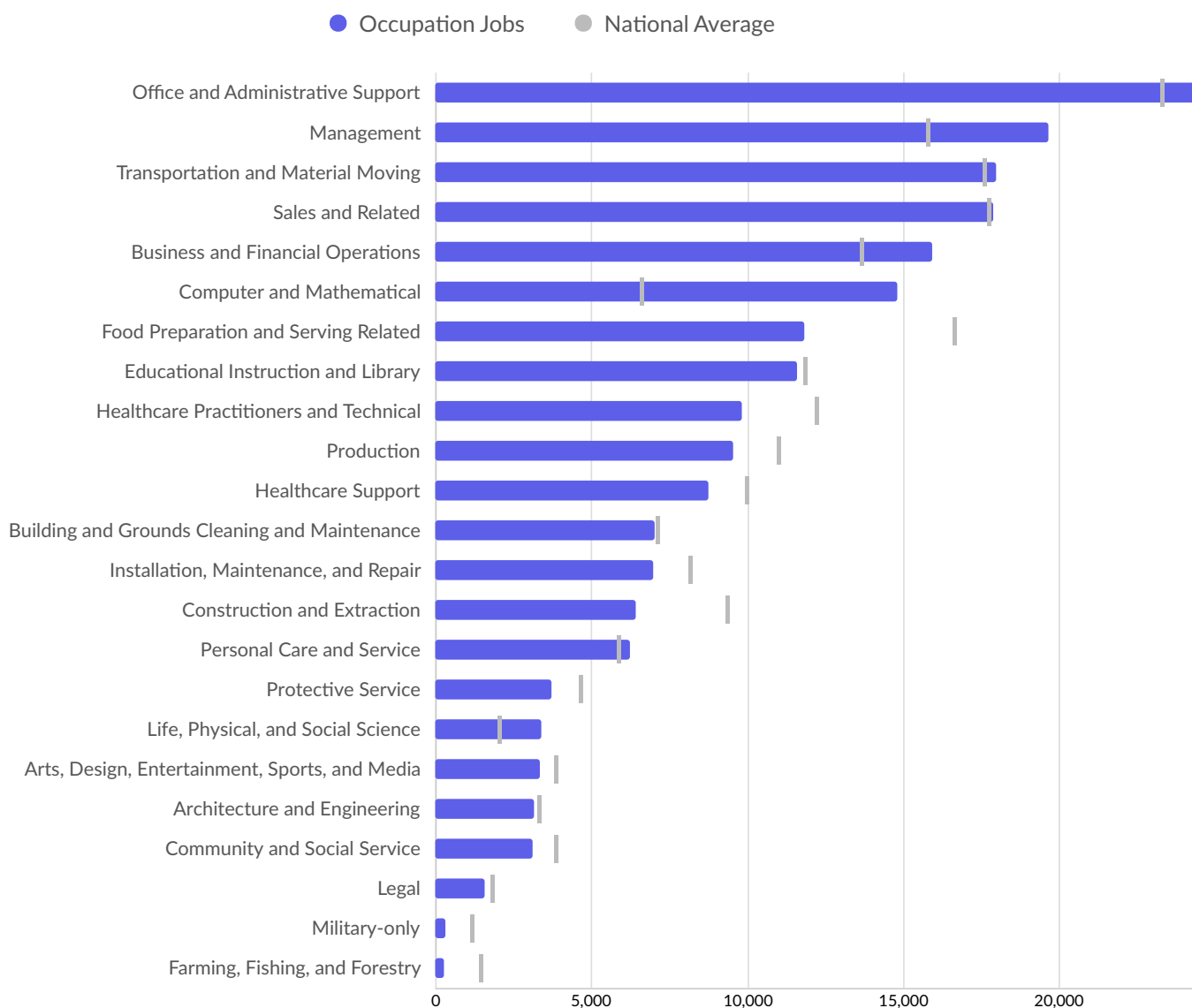

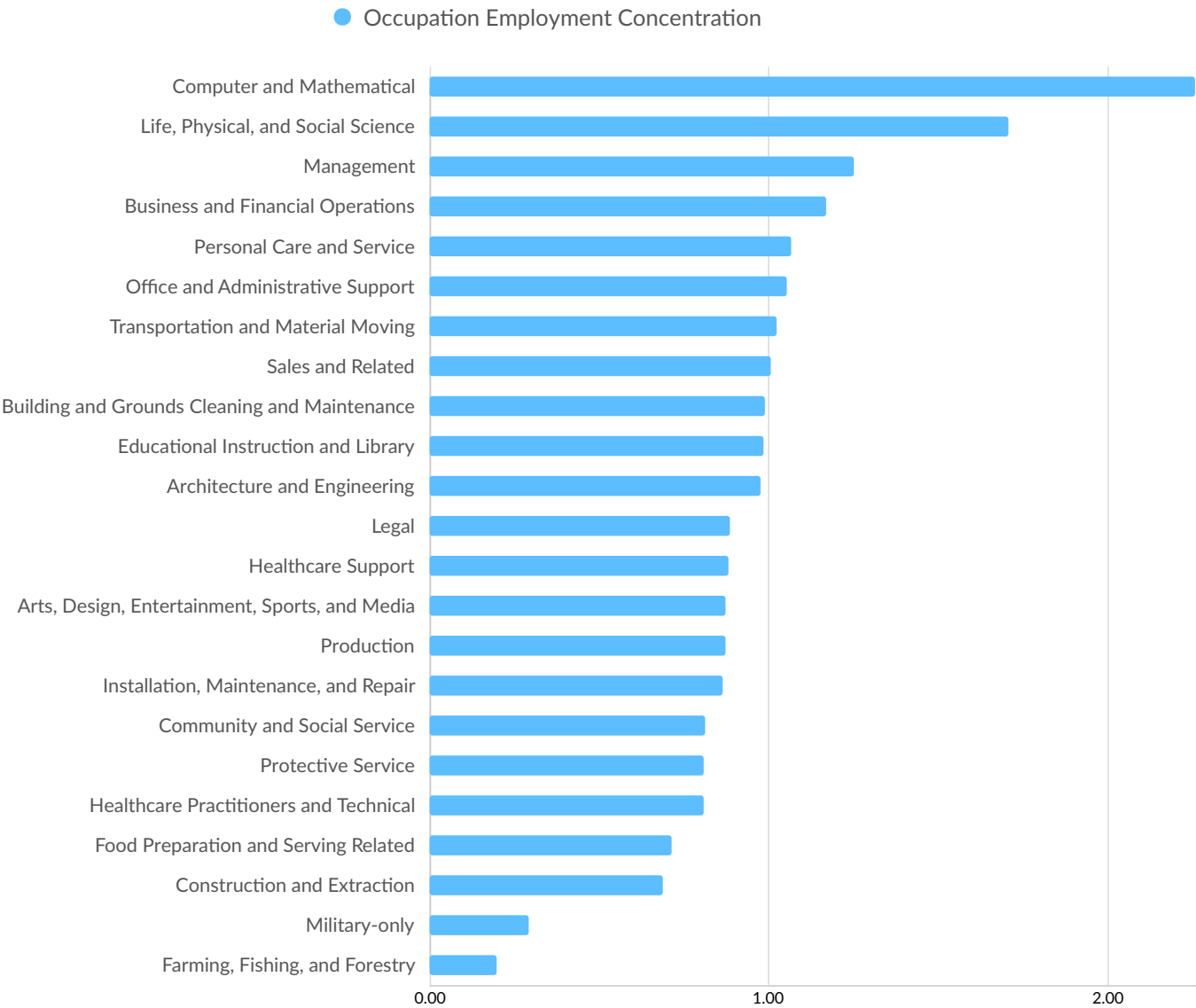
Largest Occupations



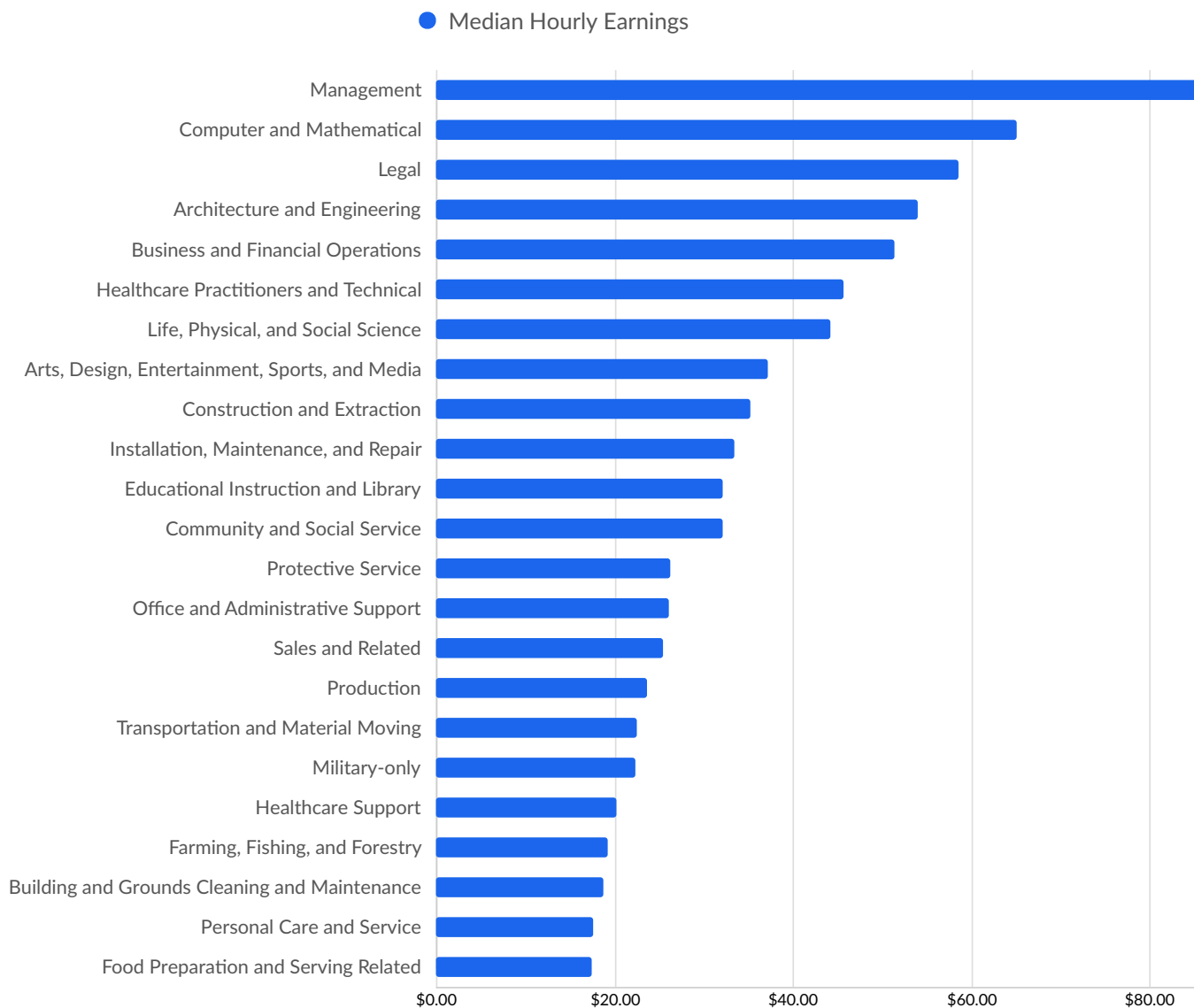
Top Growing Occupations



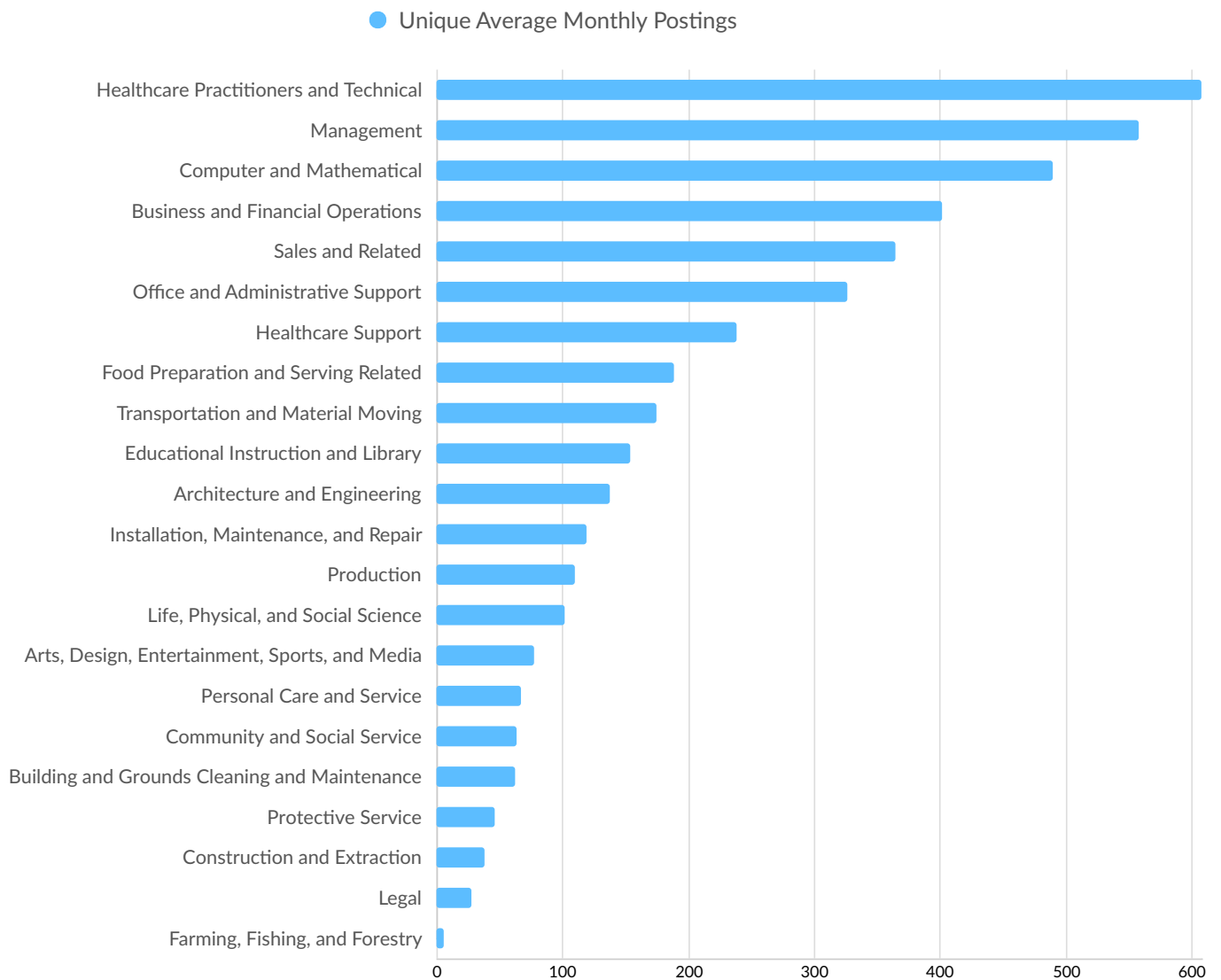
Top Occupation Employment Concentration



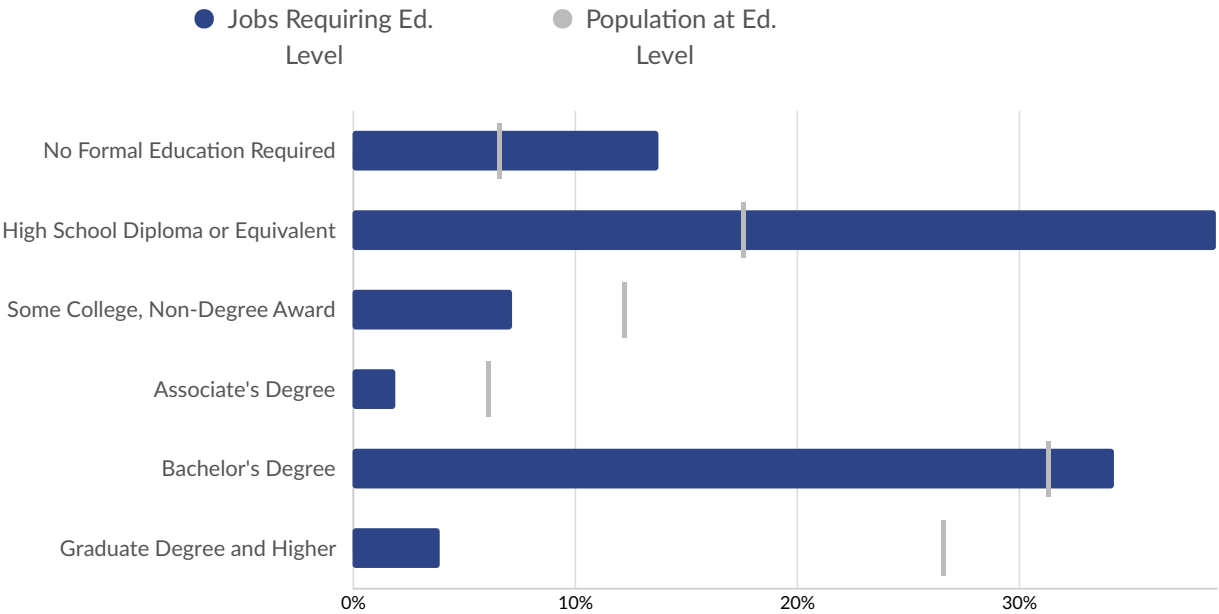
Top Occupation Earnings

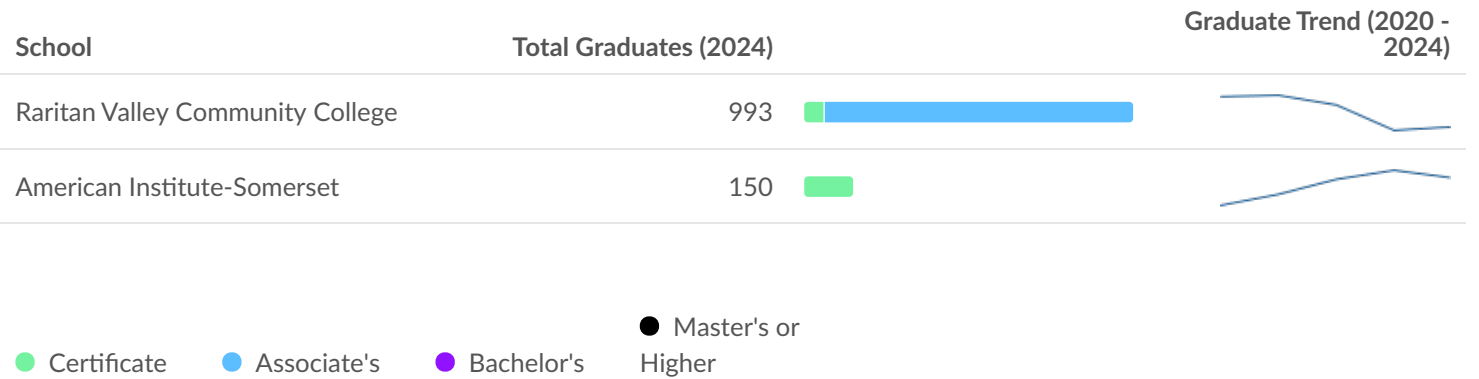
