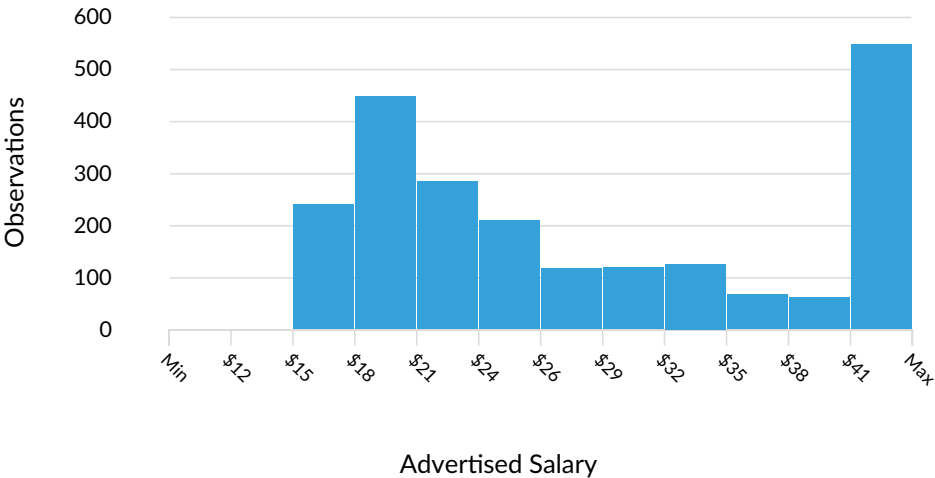

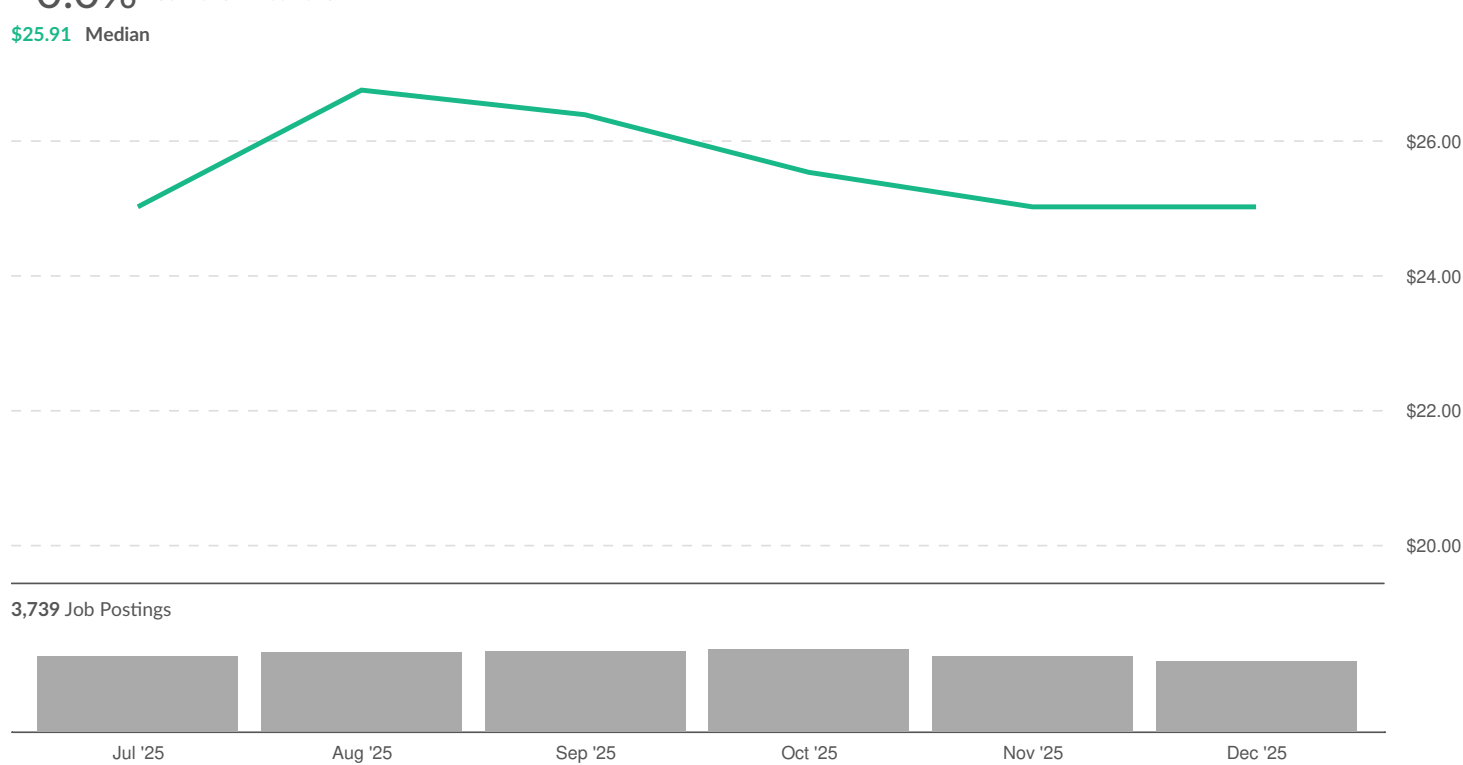

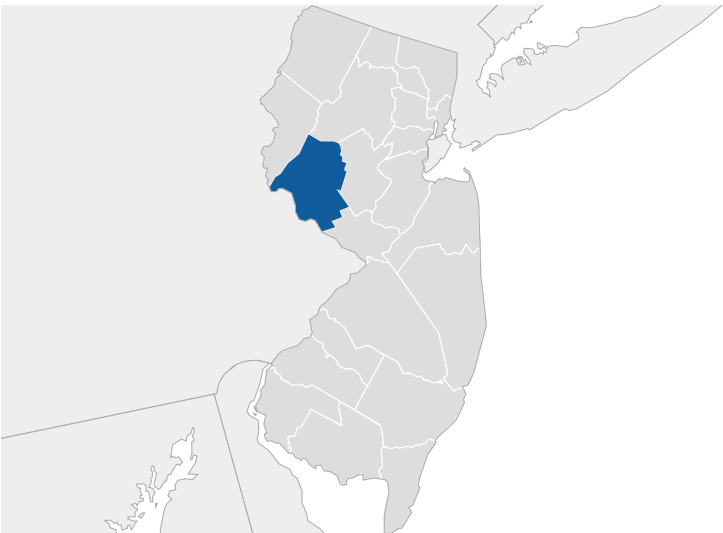


Advertised Salary Trend

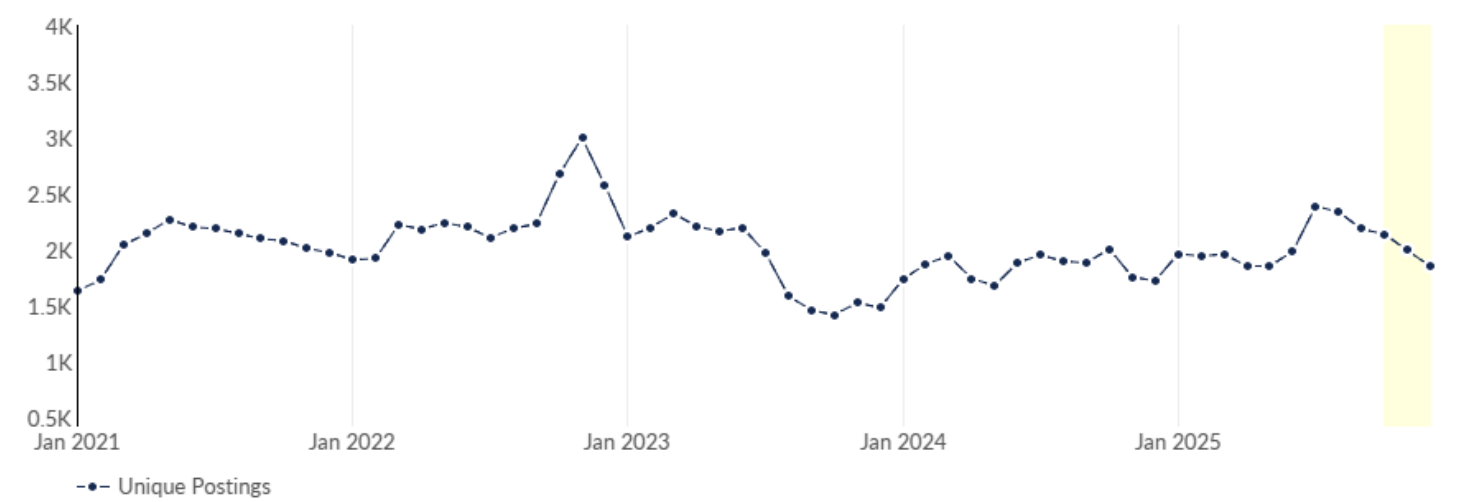
